## Agency Awards Judging Rubric



Agency awards include: Facility, Program, Department, Communication and State Park Awards

1. Primary Purpose of Project:	Applicant identifies the need for facility or program based on community surveys, resident/patron feedback or agency mission.
2. Goals & Objectives:	Applicant clearly states Goals and Objectives that are relevant to stated project purpose. Goals and objectives are specific and measurable.
3. Evaluation:	Applicant describes an intentional evaluation process and demonstrates how goals and objectives were met.
4. Community Engagement/Volunteer Resources:	Applicant identifies methods to engage community and/or secure volunteer resources critical to the successful implementation and completion of the project.
5. Sponsors and Partners:	Applicant identifies external organizations providing in-kind or cash contributions or partnerships to help with project or program. This can include sponsorships, grants, and/or material donations.
6. Challenges and Creative Solutions:	Applicant describes the challenges of the project and identifies the creative solutions implemented.
7. Overall Project Impact:	Applicant demonstrates the overall impact to the community, specifically how it has improved the quality of life.
8. Application Quality:	Application is well organized, well written, includes all necessary information and supporting documentation demonstrates the success of the project.
