Professional Awards Judging Rubric



Professional awards include: Fellow, Special Citation, Young Professional, Outstanding College/University Senior, Support, Professional of the Year, Hall of Fame, David Lose Partnership and Outstanding Public Official

1. Primary Reason of Nomination:	Applicant identifies the primary reason this person is being nominated for an award. This can include the number of years working/volunteering in the Parks and Recreation field.
2. Service:	Applicant clearly states the nominee's service to KRPS or predecessor organizations and identified leadership roles and/or work.
3. Leadership Skills:	Applicant describes how the nominee has shown leadership skills and describes the effectiveness of the nominee in promoting ideas and vision.
4. Advocacy:	Applicant identifies how the nominee's advocacy for parks and recreation has contributed to the KRPS mission.
5. Impact:	Applicant describes what the nominee has accomplished to make a lasting, positive impact through parks and recreation.
6. Application Quality:	Application is well organized, well written, includes all necessary information and supporting documentation demonstrates the success of the project.
